

1 Peter 1:22 “Truth”

“Moreover, the phrase (lit.) ‘by obedience to the truth’ (*en hypokoētēs alētheias*) probably refers to the truth of the gospel. Often in the NT the gospel is designated as ‘the truth.’”¹

⁵ and constant disagreement among people whose minds are depraved and deprived of the truth, who imagine that godliness is a way to material gain.

2 Timothy 2:15

¹⁵ Be diligent to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who doesn't need to be ashamed, correctly teaching the word of truth.

2 Timothy 2:18

¹⁸ They have departed from the truth, saying that the resurrection has already taken place, and are ruining the faith of some.

2 Timothy 2:25

²⁵ instructing his opponents with gentleness. Perhaps God will grant them repentance leading them to the knowledge of the truth.

2 Timothy 3:7

⁷ always learning and never able to come to a knowledge of the truth.

2 Timothy 3:8

⁸ Just as Jannes and Jambres resisted Moses, so these also resist the truth. They are men who are corrupt in mind and worthless in regard to the faith.

2 Timothy 4:4

⁴ They will turn away from hearing the truth and will turn aside to myths.

Titus 1:1

1 Paul, a servant of God and an apostle of Jesus Christ, for the faith of God's elect and their knowledge of the truth that leads to godliness,

¹⁴ and may not pay attention to Jewish myths and the commands of people who reject the truth.

²⁶ For if we deliberately go on sinning after receiving the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins,
